in the fore noon, then and there to enquire of, do, and execute all such things as on Her Majesty's behalf shall be lawfully given them in charge, touching the death of Louie

Bee. AND be you then and there to certify

what you shall have done in the premises: and further to do and execute what in behalf of our said Lady the Queen shall be then and there enjoined you.
