year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lady Victoria, before me, George

the District aforesaid, upon the view of the body of Louie
Bee then and there and within the jurisdiction of the
said Coroner, lying dead, upon the oaths of —

good and lawful men of New Westminster aforesaid, in the said County
who being now here sworn and charged to enquire, on the part of our
said Lady the Queen, when, where, how, and after what manner, the said Louie

Bee came to his death, do say upon their oath, that the said
Louie Bee was on the 8th day
of September instand, killed
by a shot fired by one Slumach

and that the said Slumach on
the day aforesaid at Pitt River,
in the County of Westminster, did
feloniously, wilfully and of
his malice aforethought, kill and
murder the said Louie Bee against
the peace of our Lady the Queen,
her Crown and dignity.
