- \$. That the said Moody and the said Florence Reid are important and necessary and material witnesses, and can give improtant evicence on the trial of the said Slumagh on the above charge.
- %. That the said Moody and the said Florence Reid can be produced as witnesses if the trial be postponed till the next sittings of this Court.
