

RICH PLACERS IN PITT MOUNTAINS

Several Indians have of late been bringing in large amount of gold dust from Pitt lake to New Westminster, B. C., and it is becoming generally known that the placers of Pitt lake are again to the fore. Two or three weeks ago one Indian is said to have brought in \$1600 in coarse dust, and last week \$12.
